

Dear Praying Partners,

Jan. 2009

Praise the Lord! This has been a wonderful month. We have seen the Lord do some marvelous things during the past 30 days or so. Thank you so much for praying for us during this time on deputation.

We are making plans to leave the country on the 31st of March. We praise the Lord that He has supplied our needs through deputation. Several churches have taken us on for support in the last few weeks and this has allowed us to press forward in our departure.

Because of the timely fashion in which things need to occur, we ask that you would pray about a few things. We will soon be purchasing tickets, getting a container, packing, measuring, labeling and weighing all our belongings, and working on Amanda's visa and other paperwork. Once we get to Brazil we will need to secure a place to live, purchase a vehicle, take care of my Brazilian documents, apply for Amanda's permanent visa, liberate our things from immigration, sign up for language school and much more.

Let me share with you some of the projects we have been working on and some of the doors that have recently opened for us:

1. I have once again established contact with many friends in Brazil. Some of these have shown interest in what we are doing and have already helped with advice on several different issues. We have also been in contact with many missionaries in Brazil. This has allowed us to get many questions answered and to get a better idea of how things will go in the months following our arrival in Brazil.

2. Through the website we have been able to contact pastors and lay people who are interested in starting churches, soul-winning, reaching their own family members for Christ, and some who are backslidden and need spiritual help. It has been a blessing to be able to correspond with people who are hurting and counsel with them.

3. The Lord has opened doors for us to meet and encourage Brazilians all over the globe. We are working on a project helping a church in Australia who has about 50 Brazilians attending each week. We have also met Brazilians in Canada with unsaved relatives near where we will be in Brazil.

4. We have been able to add and target a few other languages with our gospel website. Our goal is to target every one of the 10 largest minorities in Brazil. People from over 60 countries have visited our website in the last 12 months.

Time for our departure is at hand. Please pray that the Lord will give us favor with the national pastors, favor with other missionaries, but most of all favor with our God who alone can change the hearts of men. *“Now God had brought Daniel into favour and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs”* (Daniel 1:9).
