Brazil is in desperate need of the truth. Religion is everywhere! Yet, though there is much religion, few people are following the Word of God. On the 31st of October the people of Brazil voted in a socialist president, Dilma. She has publicly made statements that show her disbelief in Jesus as the Son of God. She has also made many statements that show she intends to restrict our religious liberties in this country. Even though we are disappointed in the results of the elections, we can be certain that God is in control. Romans 13 shows us that God sets up the powers in this world.

The church downtown São Paulo that we have been working with has been thrilled at our presence over the past two months. The people have been eager to receive the Word of God as we preach. However, though the people want to be independent Baptist, the pastor, having recovered more quickly than expected, has made a decision to remain under the convention. Because of our convictions, we have decided to step away and allow them to work this out on their own. We cannot overstep the pastor and do not wish to undermine his leadership.

On November 11, I will be travelling to the northwest part of Brazil to preach a mission conference, as mentioned in my previous letter. Please pray that the Word of God would work in the hearts of the people and they would decide to follow and obey the clear teaching and preaching of God's Word.
