Dear Prayer Partners, April 2014

This past month we were able to visit in an Indian tribe on a Sunday morning. We left our house about 6:30 am and arrived at the tribe at about 9am just in time for the service. Our entire family went together. This is the first time Amanda and the boys have been in an Indian tribe.

The tribe is very civilized and many have modern conveniences, motorcycles, and even satellite TV. They do not live very far from town, but the road can get a little difficult to travel, especially during the rainy season. The rain has not let up any, so our trip was very muddy. There were some rough spots, but nothing our vehicle could not handle well.

At the tribe we participated in the morning service though we did not understand anything. There was a Bible lesson, then others gave testimonies, sang, and took up an offering. At the end of the service two young women went to the front and confessed their faults asking the church to take them back into fellowship. They each gave a testimony of how the Lord had worked in their hearts and then they each prayed. The native pastors had visited and counseled with them in their homes. As soon as they finished, every person in the church lined up to shake their hands, hug them and welcome them back! What a sight!

There is much I could say about this trip, but there is no doubt in my mind that God has done and is doing a wonderful work in this tribe. Though the missionaries are still needed for translation and for their influence, the natives carry on the pastoral work and are moving the church to reach other Indian tribes around them.

During the past few weeks we have been working hard to encourage other missionaries, help them with resources, and move forward a few more projects. In the next few months, we will be launching another resource website that will have useful studies for pastors and laypeople to use in their churches. Please continue to pray for this internet ministry. This month I responded to several emails where people who were not saved were asking for prayer.

On April 21st, I will be taking another trip into the jungle. The purpose of the trip is to learn more about the work with Indians. I will be traveling with Bro. Stephen Doolittle and a few men from his church to visit a missionary that they support. I will be riding a bus for 6 hours, catching a plane for an hour, driving for 4 more hours, then getting on a boat for about 8-12 hours in order to get to the area where the missionary lives.

Please pray! We will be helping the missionary build his house in the Indian village, helping children with dental hygiene, preaching, and helping the missionary in any way possible while we are there. Pray the Lord gives us safety, the missionary is encouraged, and that spiritually this trip would make a difference in someone's life.
