As September comes to a close, we are excited about what the Lord has prepared for the next few months in the ministry here. As J. Hudson Taylor said, "God is always advancing." We are pressing forward while seeking direction from God in the ministry.

Families - Recently we have been helping a few families with some very difficult situations. We have tried to encourage them to keep trusting in the Lord throughout the difficulties. When we cannot see the hand of God and how He is working, we need to just trust that He is working. Faith should supersede sight. Meaning... We should trust God even when it looks like He is not in control. It may not have looked like God was in control of Joseph's life or Job's life. However, looking back we see that only God could have changed the course of Joseph's life from years of slavery and prison. In just one day he became the second in command of the most powerful country in the world. God knows what He is doing and we must just trust Him even when the pathway makes no sense to us!

Meeting Place - Thank you for praying about a location for us to meet. God has answered your prayers. We are in the process of signing the contract on a rental building. The contract begins on October 6, but we should have the keys before then. We plan on beginning an evangelistic outreach on Sunday evenings by the 19th of October. If all goes well, we will soon have three weekly meetings in the building. Though the building is not large, it is exactly what we need at this time. There is a small room for the children and a large room for services and meetings. Thank you for praying. As soon as possible we will get some pictures of the building on our website. There is much work to be done... chairs to be bought, a pulpit to be built, a sign to be designed, and other such things. Though these things are important, we ask you to pray specifically for the people... to attend, to be saved, to follow the Lord in baptism, and to grow spiritually.

Furlough - Over the past few weeks we have finalized a few dates for our furlough next year and have already scheduled some meetings. Our schedule will be tight, but we hope to visit most of our supporting churches. Upcoming - Plans are being made for a survey trip into another tribe in November. This tribe is considered isolated, but they have some contact with cities in the region. There are no missionaries working with them and no Gospel witness among them. Please pray for open doors!
