Our time here in the US is already more than half over. Time has been flying by. We have spent many hours in the car and visited hundreds of friends all over the country. Communication has been a bit more difficult due to the lack of a schedule.

God has been good to us on this journey. We have been to almost 25 different churches. Sometimes the road gets long and the traveling gets old, but we can still say we have been treated well and have enjoyed a lot of good fellowship along the way. While in Virginia, God gave us the privilege of meeting a Brazilian family and encouraging them to follow the Lord. They were also a great blessing to us.

Once again, furlough marks another change in our ministry. When leaving Brazil, we turned our rental house back in and will be moving upon our return to the field. For the past three years we have been helping John and Julie Kokenzie in the city of Ouro Preto do Oeste where the church is growing and moving forward under their leadership. The work there is still very young and needs much prayer as believers are growing in their relationships with the Lord.

God is moving us about six hours south to the city of Vilhena. It is a larger city, but still in the state of Rondônia. Two other missionary families are already at work. In February, Isaías and Rachel Divino moved into the city and shortly afterward Ed Cook and his wife also moved up there. We are excited about joining them in September when we return to Brazil.

We have been able to make a little progress over the past few months on websites, but there is always much more work to do. Please pray that the Lord would bless in all of the work that is being done online. Also, pray that God would help the literature that is being put out to be a blessing and help to many pastors and missionaries all over Brazil.

Please continue to pray for us as we finish up the rest of our traveling. Pray that God would give us safety and that He would prepare a place for us when we get to Vilhena.
