I would like to thank all of you for praying for us. As we go from church to church on furlough, we have been asking people to pray and God is already answering prayers. Please continue to pray as we seek God's direction in the ministry.

PRAYER REQUESTS

- 1. Please pray that God will open doors for us to minister to the Indian tribes in our area. God has already granted some favor, but we ask for continued prayer as we will face many difficult barriers through the years ahead.
- 2. Pray for the beginning of the new church. As we witness for the Lord around the city, pray that people would open their hearts to Bible truth, that they would believe that Jesus is the only means of salvation, and that they would grow in the Lord and in the knowledge of His Word. Several people have shown interest and one family has attended the initial meetings regularly.
- 3. Pray that God would prepare a house for us upon our return. We are already looking at a few houses over the internet and have a few areas in mind, but nothing will be settled for sure until we arrive in person and are able to work out the details. There are plenty of houses available, but we are praying specifically for a few things we would like to have in a house that we did not have before. We would like to be in a house within a week of our arrival, but even if this does not happen, we know God already has a place reserved for us
- 4. Pray for our return trip to Brazil. We have tickets to fly out on September 2nd. We are thanking the Lord that our flights have been changed giving us only a 3 hour layover in São Paulo, instead of 17 hours. There will still be a long bus ride after our last flight. Our main concern is that the luggage all arrives with us in one piece!

God is blessing in a great way in the church in Ouro Preto do Oeste. We are thankful for the Kokenzies and the work they are doing there. There has been a good number of people in attendance in the Sunday evening services. Several families are attending regularly. Please continue to pray. The building we rented last October is already very small for the church. They are looking for a new location. Please pray God will guide in the decision and provide a place.

Also, pray for the people at the church. Some still need to be saved, but others need to grow in the Lord. There is much religious confusion in the country. Because of this confusion, people have many questions that need to be settled by means of Bible teaching. Pray for John as well that the Lord will give him wisdom in leading the people and helping them understand God's will for the church.
