Here is a little summary of what has been going on over the past few months.

NOVEMBER

At the end of November, we had the privilege of traveling about 8 hours north to have Thanksgiving with several other missionary families. The fellowship was a special blessing. Immediately after Thanksgiving, Dad and I flew to Limeira to finish packing their belongings, load the truck, and drive 1,500 miles back to Vilhena. The roads were great most of the way and their belongings arrived without any issue. This was an answer to prayer.

DECEMBER

It was a special blessing to have my parents near us this Christmas. Our schedules were full with many activities including moving my parents into their rental house and helping them get things cared for. Some repairs were made and they are mostly settled. We were able to spend some time together on Christmas day opening gifts, reading our Bibles together and talking about the birth of Christ.

JANUARY

We started off the year inviting a few friends over to our house. New Years day was a special day and we enjoyed a good time of fellowship with other believers as well as a few who we are working with.

Now that my parents are around, we are trying to show them around the area, introduce them to pastors and let them visit a few of the churches in the area. We traveled to São Felipe about three hours northwest of Vilhena. Other trips were planned, but due to a recent lockdown and restrictions, we have had to cancel those trips. We ask you to pray that these restrictions will not hinder work over the next few months and our plans for furlough this summer. The Lord is not surprised at any of this and will guide us and help us be flexible in the way as He leads us.

We began a Bible study on the 5th of January to help some friends get answers from the Bible. We are addressing all of the basics with hope that they will have certainty of their salvation, settle issues with baptism, join the church and grow spiritually. God is doing some wonderful things in their lives.

FURLOUGH AND BEYOND

We have purchased our tickets for furlough from April 14th to September 14th. The boys are working hard to finish school. Josiah will be graduating and starting college in the fall. We hate to see him leave, but we are excited to see him following the Lord's leading in His life. He is a great help and will be greatly missed.
