Another blessing is seeing the church people getting involved in the Lord's work. This kind of outreach is new and the people need more practice. However, it encourages us to see the people volunteering and getting involved in every aspect of the church.

Two of our men have had opportunities to teach Sunday School. We started a series on Bible Chronology for a few months. Both men have done an excellent job explaining the Bible events in a chronological order as well as getting people more interested in studying on their own.

My parents have been on the other side of the country for almost a month. During their absence, the Lord has given us opportunities to be a blessing to other churches. Though we were already short on workers, I was still able to preach for another church while our people took care of our own church service. They also picked up people for the service, took the responsibility of caring for a visiting speaker, and took care of many other details. God is working and answering prayers! Keep praying for the spiritual growth of our people.

We are beginning to see our church people open up about spiritual problems. Some are battling salvation, others need to be baptized, and many need to make changes in their lives. There is evidence that the Holy Spirit is at work behind the scenes.

April still is not over! On the 23rd we are planning to take a group of 17 people (including adults) to a teen activity in the city of Ouro Preto where we helped the Kokenzies start a church. The church has grown since we left in 2015 and we are glad to be close enough now that our churches can have some fellowship. We are using this opportunity to take several teens from our church and from three other churches around us.

Sam Rogers is another missionary in our state whose church will participate in the event. This past Sunday he came and preached for us while I was preaching in another church. Please pray for the Rogers. They will be leaving for furlough in a few days and taking a daughter to college. We have had quite a bit of fellowship over the years and our children have grown up together. As missionaries, many times, fellow missionaries become like family to us. God has blessed us with good friends and fellow laborers in the ministry. We cherish the memories as we continue serving the Lord.
