We greet you for the first time this wonderful year. What a year it has been already! I pray you are rejoicing in the Lord's blessings this year and have already found much to thank Him for. If you cannot find anything else to be thankful for, be thankful for your salvation. Answers to prayer abound! It would be impossible to describe everything God has already done for us this year. Yet, some of it must be shared. Here are some of the recent blessings and answered prayers from here in Cacoal.

We recently signed the contract for the sale of our house in Vilhena. We are now awaiting documentation processing to receive the remaining funds. Thank you to all who have prayed. A few have reminded us frequently that they were praying for the sale of our house. Please keep praying as we seek the Lord's will concerning housing here. We are praying specifically and expecting God to answer specifically.

Many of our church people have never been challenged in their daily walk with God. This year I challenged all of our people to begin reading the Bible. We decided to start with reading through the New Testament this year. I was hoping to get 10-12 people to participate. We are nearing the end of February and at least 20 people are faithfully reading. Hallelujah! People that do not even attend our church are reading with us.

You have been praying about the children's ministry in our church. God is answering your prayers. Please do not stop. We started three weeks of training for the children's ministry. Last Saturday we had four church people participating, and this week we expect at least six. On March 11th we will be holding a Bible club at the church trying to reach new children. We continue praying for workers for this ministry and for Sunday School.

One of the young ladies in our church is Talyeni. She has been involved in two motorcycle accidents within the last 13 months. She has been through three knee surgeries and has not been back to work in over a year. Yet, God is working in her life in a wonderful way. She is very involved in the church and has a tender heart to follow God. She helped our young people win another round of Bible quizzing in January.

Talyeni and her brother, Daniel, are two of my piano students. They have been challenged to learn enough hymns to play for several months during the summer. We have four pianists right now, but all four of us will be traveling back to the US this summer as we get Jonathan settled in for college. Please keep praying! The Lord is sending laborers as we have requested. This week two men readily agreed to help with the adult Sunday School class.

As I close this letter, I ask that you pray for souls to be saved. There are several people we have been working with for a long time who have yet to trust Christ as their Savior. This is a great burden on us. We count on your partnership with us in this ministry. Thank you for your friendship! Thank you for investing! Thank you for praying!
