"Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!" (Psalm 133:1)

"Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind... Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 2:2 and 5)

Oddly enough, the subject of unity is one that many people disagree on. Yet, we are admonished many times in the Scriptures to be likeminded. Being likeminded can only happen when we have the mind of Christ.

As we finish up the month of April, our biggest prayer request for the Berean Baptist Church (Igreja Batista Bereiana) here in Cacoal is unity. Please pray with us that the church will be united despite differences.

The next three months will be a challenge for our church as well as for our family. As I detail these prayer requests, I would like to remind you that God is answering prayers. 3. Pray for our boys. **Josiah** is doing well in college and excelling in his grades as well as other areas. **Jonathan** will be adjusting to life in the US and we would appreciate your prayers for him. He is easy going but will have a challenge getting acclimated to college life. **Judson** spends most of his spare time in sign language ministry, playing the piano and writing.
