Greetings from Cacoal! It is a privilege to be able to serve the Lord at such a time as this. The world is not getting any better. It seems as though there are always new things rising up to distract hearts and minds from thinking about the Lord. Even in the church, problems and distractions seem to get our attention and we many times allow our eyes to focus on earthly things. Yet, we must say that God is still working in the hearts of men!

March was full of blessings. Let me share a few with you. Rogério and Edna started attending the church in July of 2024 during an evangelistic conference. After having a good conversation with them, Rogério said he wanted to be baptized. He was baptized in March! Along with this couple, three other ladies have asked to join the church during the last few months. We are working with them toward this goal.

I had the privilege of speaking to the men and participating in a discussion panel with other preachers.

We have also been working hard on our building plans. We now have a draft of a simple blueprint and are working on getting it laid out the way we believe would be most suitable for the church. There needs to be a balance between cost and necessity. God has not given us unlimited resources, though we have big dreams. It seems as though our original time line has given place to reality. The architect has been traveling for several weeks this month, so we will resume plans early in May. This delay has given us time to think through many scenarios and plans for the future of the church.

April began with a wonderful Easter Sunday remembering our risen Savior. It will end with a trip to one of the Zoró villages to encourage our indigenous missionaries. I will be in the village on April 28-30. Please pray for this trip. We will have time to talk, plan, and pray together about future opportunities for this tribe. Lord willing, I will be participating in Vacation Bible Schools in two different tribes during the month of July also.

Please pray for my parents, Garry and Pam Tyler. They have been dealing with several health issues recently. Also pray for our trip back to the US in June. We are returning to participate in our son's wedding. We have been blessed by your prayers and continued encouragement. Thank you for standing with us!
