God is good! It doesn't matter who you are, where you live, or what you believe. The fact remains that *God is good!*

On June 16th, Amanda and I celebrated our 25th wedding anniversary by attending our son Josiah's wedding to Jaina. It was a beautiful wedding and we are happy to have Jaina as part of our family. We thank God for His *goodness* in giving Josiah a wife that loves the Lord and has a desire to serve Him. We made a quick trip to the US for the wedding during the month of June. Josiah and Jaina moved to Waco, TX where Josiah will be attending law school. Jonathan and Judson are at Pensacola Christian College and have been working all summer on campus. Please pray for Jonathan as he will be entering his senior year and searching for what doors God will open after this year. Judson will be a sophomore in the fall.

Recently a young man about 30 years old got lost in the jungle while hunting. He had been in the Zoró village where we planned to hold a VBS the next week. Due to the efforts of many that were searching the jungle for days, the VBS was delayed. Not knowing what the future would hold, we prayed and trusted the Lord. His *goodness* allowed the young man to be found after 5 days. Not only was he found, but we were able to hold the VBS a few weeks later.

I wish I had the time to tell you every detail of His *goodness* during the VBS. I have posted some pictures on our website for those who wish to see them. We had 38 kids enrolled and over 40 adults present for the VBS. The Lord worked in a special way bringing 5 young ones to salvation. We also baptized 7 young people by the end of the week. Praise the Lord!

The trip to the Indian village took me over 150 miles into the jungle. About 120 of those miles were on a dirt road. Some of the road was rocky, overridden by jungle brush, or just plain dusty. We crossed dozens of small log bridges. The Lord was *good* in giving us safety there and back. Our native missionary friend hit a rock and punctured his gas tank. Most of the gas leaked out, but he was able to stop the leak with epoxy glue. The Lord supplied a little more gas and he made it home safely!

Having added 3 new members to the church this past month, we are already seeing them get involved serving the Lord. Isn't God *good*? Our church people have been giving in a special way to the work of the Lord. They gave a special offering in July to the pastors and congregations in Venezuela who suffered a massive earthquake. They also gave offerings, food, and clothing for the VBS in the Indian village.

Living in the Amazon area brings many challenges. Termites are one of them! The termites have found the wood in the roof of our house, and we were forced to make some repairs. In a few weeks I hope to update you on our church building plans. I am meeting again with the architect this week. We hope to finalize the plans soon and move forward with the work.
